**5.1** Ward Councillor Mr Peter Jinman reported on the following:-New round of Lengthsman funding available (£250k)

"Lengthsman Grant: The general lengthsman grant has now finally gone through all the governance hoops and is available to parish councils who have a lengthsman registered with BBLP. I am very sorry about the delay. This grant will be £250k per year for 5 years and we hope it will go some way to allowing PCs to do some of the work that BBLP won't get to due to historic reduced funding for the annual plan and the maintenance matrices we have to use to make sure we satisfy government criteria for optimal management of the highways network/public realm. We are also revising the criteria BBLP use to validate parish lengthsman so that parishes can employ lengthsmen who don't hold all the licences required to work on all roads etc. but instead will allow PCs to tailor their own lengthsmen to their own needs/what is available to them, and still be able to register with BBLP/HC in order to be eligible for match funding via the Lengthsman grant or any other grants that may come along. BBLP should have sent out notification for PCs to apply for grants for what's left of this financial year."
